Recycle Bin Search Removed in Lightning

- Recycle bin was recently added to Lightning
- Search feature removed for performance reasons
- Recycle bin list views still support filtering criteria

Email Attachment Size Limit Increase

- Email attachments sent from Salesforce increased from 25MB to 35MB
- Many email recipients will still cap at 25MB, such as gmail

Dynamic Forms are GA for custom objects

- GA status only applies to Custom Objects
- Standard objects still in beta, scheduled for Spring 21 and Summer 21









Optimizer App updates

- Scheduled runs. Run automatically every month
- Org Metric History, such as file and data storage limits
- Enhanced security scoring by checking permission assignments, crit update activations and guest users

Lightning Page Performance (Demo)

- Get better information on lighting page performance considerations
- Click the Analyze button when editing a Lightning Page









HTML Email Builder (Demo)

- Drag and drop HTML elements builder for Lightning Email Templates
- Users need Access Drag-and-Drop Content Builder or Manage Content Builder permissions.
- Only works for new templates. Cannot use builder on existing Classic or Lightning email templates.

Recent Opportunity Changes on Kanban View (Demo)

- See recent changes to Amounts and Close Dates on opportunities
- Color and arrows indicate amount and close dates that changed int he last 7 days
- Green for increased amounts and earlier close dates. Red for deceased amounts and pushed out dates.
- Can remove one or both settings from the Opportunity Settings in Setup.







Auto Add to New Fields To Custom Report Types (Beta)

- Option to automatically add new custom fields to all custom report types that use the object.
- Use Auto add new custom fields to custom report type layouts in Reports and Dashboard Settings in Setup.

Custom Notifications

- Use the target Page Reference field on the Send Custom Notification action in REST API or Flows.
- Redirect to any PageReference, such as a record, Lightning App or External URL.







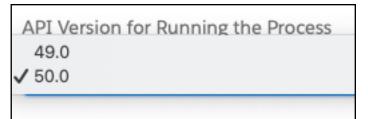

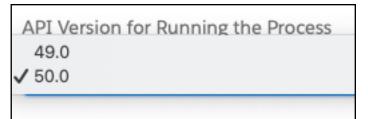


API Versioning on Flows and Processes

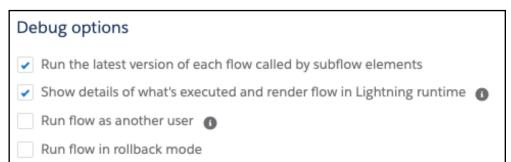


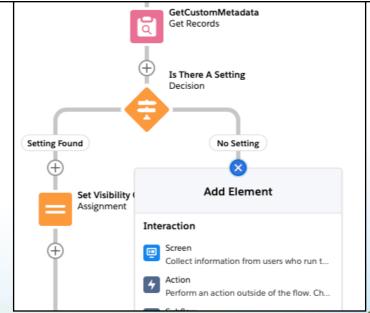
Flow Columns

 Flow list can now show triggering action and if the API is up to date

Debug and UI Enhancements

- Run flow as another user without needing to do a login as
- Debug on Canvas for non triggered autolaunch flows
- Auto layout option for elements











Before Delete Flows (Demo)

- Flow that automatically runs before a record is deleted
- You cannot stop the deletion process in the flow
- Use to get related records, create new records, save off values
- Flow cannot be triggered from an undelete operation
- No rollback of the 'Before Delete' roll in the event of an undeletion.
